Accubar Manual

Support Guide for Exporting and Importing from Handhelds

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Accubar

In order to import data from Accubar into Aspect, the item numbers in Accubar must be identical to those in Aspect. To view the item numbers in Aspect:

1. Select Edit Inventory Items from the Inventory menu
2. Click on the binoculars, then on the Custom button at the bottom
3. Double-click on "Record No." In the list of available fields on the left and press Ok.
4. The code for each item will be displayed in the column labeled "Record No."

The item numbers entered into Accubar must be identical to the numbers you see in this display. These numbers may not be changed in Aspect. They must be entered into Accubar. When the numbers for each item are the same in both Aspect and Accubar you are ready to begin importing counts from Accubar.

Here are some things to know....

1. Aspect automatically assigns a record number to every item. This is displayed in the Record No. column of Edit Inventory Items. It absolutely, positively, can't be changed. And there is no reason to want to change it.
2. An item with the same name and an Alternate ID matching the Aspect record number must exist in Accubar for every item in Aspect. The Alternate Id number must be keyed into Accubar manually.
3. When a new item is added to Aspect, the same item must be added to Accubar with an Alternate ID that matches the Aspect record number. There is currently no provision for automatically copying new items from Aspect to Accubar.

Aspect will look something like this:

Record No.	Item Name
1000	Budweiser
1001	Bud Light

Accubar will look something like this:

Alternate ID	Item Name
1000	Budweiser
1001	Bud Light

When everything has been set up correctly, export files from Accubar are imported into Aspect by right-clicking in the Aspect Edit Inventory Count window and select Import From Handheld. The Export To Handheld function will never be used except by Accubar when they set up a new customer who is already using Aspect.

Accubar FAQ

Will users always need to add items to both Aspect and Accubar?

No you only need to add the items to Aspect, export them, and Accubar would pick up the new items.
